ELIGIBILITY FOR GAANN FELLOWSHIP

- Have a strong GPA with a strong desire to conduct research.

FELLOWSHIP BENEFITS

- Fellowship stipend: **up to \$37,000** annually (based on demonstrated financial need).
- Educational Allowance: **up to \$19,033** annually to cover tuition, fees and research related expenses.
- Opportunity to conduct cutting-edge research with leading faculty in the field and obtain supervised teaching experience.
