Andrew and Merrill Silver Scholarship

The Andrew and Merrill Silver Scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to incoming freshmen who are graduates of the Bronx High School of Science or James Madison High School. In order to be eligible to apply for this award the student must meet the following conditions:

- Student must be an incoming freshman who will be a graduate of Bronx High School of Science or James Madison High School
- Student must be a New York State resident
- Student must demonstrate a commitment to social action and/or social service by volunteering a minimum of 100 hours while at Bronx Science or James Madison
- Student must be matriculated and enrolled full time
- Student must demonstrate financial need as determined by the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Student FAFSA data must contain a combined family Federal Adjusted Gross Income of less than or equal to \$100,000
- Student's high school record must demonstrate high academic achievement

In order to continue receiving the complete four-year award of \$5,000 per academic year:

- Student must maintain full-time continuous enrollment for four years, beginning with their fall semester admit term
- Student must be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 at the end of their freshmen year and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.25 in subsequent years
- Student must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct
- Student must demonstrate commitment to social action and/or social service by volunteering a minimum of 15 hours per semester while at Stony Brook. Student will be required to submit a statement describing their volunteer activities each year, signed by a supervisor of the agency or organization they served.
- Student must continue to demonstrate financial need and must have a combined family Federal Adjusted Gross Income of less than or equal to \$100,000 as determined by the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
